Field Marshall Wilhelm Keitel officially signed the unconditional surrender of all German forces to representatives of the USSR, USA, Great Britain and France at 23:01 Central European time. The site also served as the Soviet occupation Army's Berlin HQ up until 1994. Outside there is still lots of old Soviet tanks and artillery pieces. Tickers your fancy?
