The memorial and museum to German resistance to Nazis is situated in the Bendlerblock which served as the HQ of the Wehrmacht (German Land Forces) until it finally surrendered to Russian forces at 06.00 2nd of May 1945. It was from here that Stauffenberg and his co-conspirators planned the failed 1944 assassination attempt on Hitler. Stauffenberg was executed here in the courtyard here to the words of "Long live our holy Germany!" The tour focuses on Germans that were opposed to Hitler and tries to answer some of the more difficult questions as why there wasn't more opposition.
