Between 1949 and 1990, roughly four million people left East Germany (GDR) for West Germany (FRG). 1,350,000 of these individuals passed through the Marienfelde Refugee Centre. Established in 1953 in the Berlin district of Marienfelde, individuals fleeing East Germany were housed and cared for at the Centre. Here the refugees also underwent the process required to obtain a residence permit for West Germany and West Berlin. The centre remains in use today processing among others ethnic Germans from Eastern Europe. Spaces are limited so please let the reception know if you are interested.
