The tour will take us through the last surviving Nazi forced labour camp in Berlin. During the Second War there were more than 3000 accommodation areas forced labour workers. This camp was built in 1943 for 2,000 people to work in nearby munitions factories and consists of 13 barracks. It housed civilian forced labours from different countries as well as people from concentration camps.
